# Learning Focus areas linking to the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)

These are some of the areas we are focusing on this half term. We have also included a few suggested ways for you to help your child at home.

Our main focus this half term is all about 'People who help us' and different occupations. We will be encouraging lots of role play, including the Doctors, Cafe, Vets and a construction site. We will also be using stories and reference books with the children.

(EYFS- Show an interest in occupations)

At home, you could talk about the different jobs that people do – for example: teachers, doctors and fire fighters. If you know someone who helps others (Dentist, Nurse, Fire Fighter etc), please let us know as we would love them to come in and talk to the children.









During this half term we will be talking about the life cycle of plants and preparing our vegetable patch for growing flowers, fruits and vegetables. This gives us an opportunity to talk with the children about healthy foods and they can hopefully taste the foods that we grow. We will also be sending home sunflower and runner bean seeds. (*EYFS - Plant seeds and care for growing plants. Understand the key features of the life cycle of a plant).*
